"My name is *Martha E. Dorsey* I am *25* years old and
I reside in Baltimore, Md. at No. *Catonville*, Md. Street.

I have been intimately acquainted with *Marriet Green* and her deceased husband, *Allen Green*, ^{from youth.} She was never married before she married *Allen Green*, and he was not previously married. They were never divorced but lived together up till his death. She has not since remarried and has owned no property, real, personal, or mixed, and the said *Allen* left her none except the small country place where she lives. It would cost about for a month expenses on this house are *\$4* a week, 25 cts a year ground rent, *Wheat* and *tax* 12, leaving her only *\$5.25* net income per year.
