Rheumatism: His movements lead us to believe that he
suffers severely with rheumatism. He has no deformity or
limitation of motion of joints. He stoops over and re-
covers himself with difficulty, owing to pain and soreness
in the muscles of his back and thighs.

Heart is normal in size, function and position.

Hydrocele: He has a right hydrocele, 3x5 inches in diam-
eter. No varicocele or hernia of either side.

Varicose Veins: His right internal and external sahe-
non veins are varicose to an average diameter of 1/2
inch, as high as the middle of the thigh. The integument
is sound and shows no tendency to rupture.

Senile Debility: His back is bent and his steps are feeble.
He shows evidence of decrepitude. He has no organic di-
sease. No arous senilis. No arterio sclerosis. He can
do but little manual labor.

Lungs are in healthy condition. Chest symmetrical, ex-
piration 34, rest 35, inspiration 37.

He has no disease of Kidneys. Urine dark amber. S. G.
1022. Acid. No sugar or albumen.

No other disability found to exist.

He presents no evidences of vicious habits.

We find that the aggregate permanent disability for earn-
ing a support by manual labor is due to Rheumatism, Right
Hydrocele, Varicose Veins of Right Leg, and Senile Debility,
not due to vicious habits, and warrant a rating of \$10.00.
