Name of the patient. Rheumatism and disease of heart, lungs, kidneys, back and ears, bladder, head and hydrocele right side, malarial poisoning, dyspepsia-injury to arm.

He receives a pension of 6 dollars per month.

Here give the statement of the patient in regard to the origin of his disabilities and date when first discovered by him. Varicose veins, rheumatism, hydrocele for years, cause unknown-last attack of malaria 6 years ago.

Birthplace, Howard Co. Md. Age, 65 years; height, 5-9 1/2 weight, 126 pounds; complexion, sallow; color of eyes, brown; color of hair, black; occupation, farmer; permanent marks and scars other than those described below, none

We hereby certify that upon examination we find the following objective conditions:

Pulse rate, 72-72-84; respiration, 18-18-24; temperature, N.

RHEUMATISM-Soreness and crepitation in both shoulder joints with pain complained of upon motion-no enlargement of joints-no atrophy or swelling of muscles-no contraction or impaired motion. Also complains of pain in lumbar muscles upon stooping no atrophy or swelling. All other muscles and joints normal.

DISEASE OF HEART-The heart is normal in size, position and action. Apex beat in 5th left interspace-no dilatation, hypertrophy, dyspnoea, edema or cyanosis.

DISEASE OF LUNGS-Chest at rest 36-full inspiration 36-full expiration 36. Percussion and auscultation reveal a normal condition of lungs and bronchi.

DISEASE OF KIDNEYS-Urine clear and amber color-reaction acid-no albumin, sugar or other abnormal deposits.

DISEASE OF EARS-No evidence of ear disease-hearing normal-can hear an ordinary conversation with either ear at distance of six feet.

DISEASE OF BLADDER-No evidence of bladder disease.

DISEASE OF HEAD-No evidence of disease of head.

HYDROCELE RIGHT SIDE-There is a hydrocele of right side of 11 inches in circumference which has been tapped 20 times and last time this spring-no hernia or varicocele.

MALARIAL POISONING-No chill or fever present-condition of stomach, skin, spleen and liver normal-upper border of liver corresponds to 5th rib and lower border to 10th rib. The digestive functions properly performed.

DYSPEPSIA-No objective evidence.

INJURY TO ARM-No evidence of injury to arm.

VARICOSE VEINS-There is a varicose condition of internal saphenous of right leg from midway of thigh to ankle-largest 3/4 inch in diameter-no tendency to rupture-surrounding integument healthy-left leg normal.

No other disability found to exist.

No evidence of vicious habits.

We find that the aggregate permanent disability for earning a support by manual labor is due to rheumatism, hydrocele, varicose veins of right leg and age not due to vicious habits, and warrants a rate of \$6 a month.
