Declaration for Pension of Children under Sixteen years of age,

 On this 14th day of February A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy seventy
 personally appeared before me Thomas Gorsuch Clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick County
 the same being a court of record within and for the county and State aforesaid Otto J. Keller
 a resident of Buckeystown county of Frederick in the State of Maryland
 aged thirty three years, who, being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain the pension
 provided by Acts of Congress for children under sixteen years of age: That he is the only legal guardian of John Henry Dorey
and Linton Thomas Dorey.

legitimate children of Charles Dorey
 who resided under the name of Charles Dorey
 at Frederick on the 2nd day of April in the year 1864
in Company D. 1st Reg. C. Corps.
 in the war of 1861 who died near Fort Fisher in the State of
North Carolina of the Yellow Fever contracted while in the discharge of his duty
the exact time & place not known all of which is proven in the claim of his widow
Sarah E. Dorey in which a pension certificate No. 11212 was issued. A. D. 18 70
 and who bore at the time of his death the rank of a private

that he left a widow surviving him who has remarried to John Maule, that she remarried
on the 4th day of October A. D. 1870 proof of which is her oath & affidavit
 that the above-named are the only surviving legitimate children of said Charles Dorey
 who were under sixteen years of age at the time of his death, of whom none have died, which with the
 dates of their birth are also proven in said No. 11212

That said children were the issue of said soldier as follows, the dates of their birth being as hereinafter stated:
