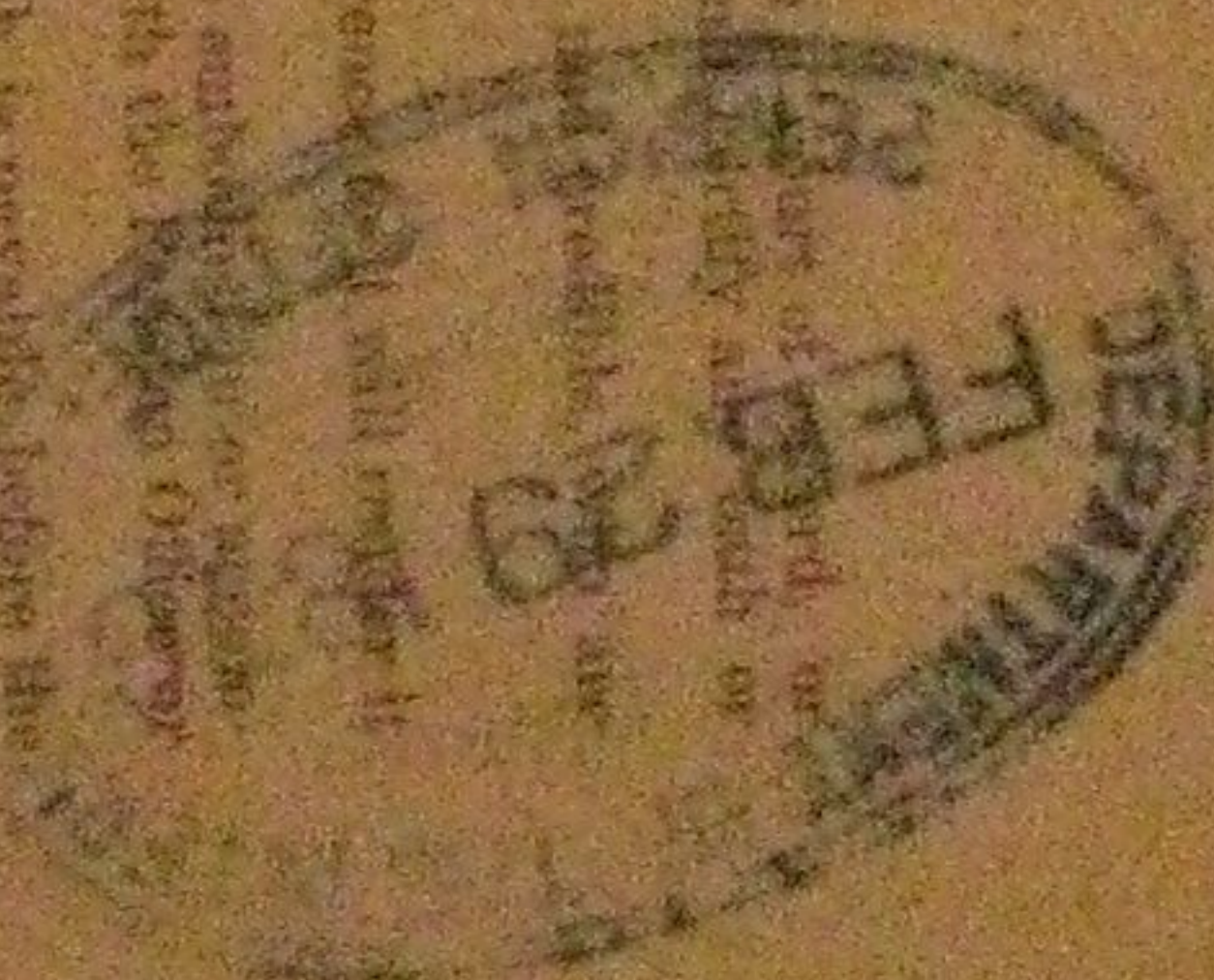

All the blanks in this form should be carefully filled and the requirements of the notes strictly observed.

As heretofore prescribed from the service in all cases is necessary.

Declarations of claimants, either for original pension or for increase of pension already granted, must be made before a justice of the peace, or other officer having authority in that behalf, and before some other officer having authority in that behalf, and before some other officer having authority in that behalf.

The claimant's identity and loyalty must be proved by two witnesses, certified by the judicial officer to be respectable and credible, and sworn to before the claimant, and other papers should be as legal and as clear in statement as possible.

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When any witness is already on file in any department of the Government, a definite description of him and specific reference to his file will enable the pension agent to find him.

The pension agent should be stated.

The first for the presentation of claims for pensions will not be allowed to exceed twenty-five dollars; no part of which is payable before the pension is granted.

Persons desiring to complete claims pending at the close of the calendar, must furnish a duly sworn affidavit of their authority as heirs or legal representatives.

To facilitate the application of claims, all the requisite evidence that is available should be forwarded with the application.
