

New York, at N. Y. on the first of April & Sept.
For New Jersey, at Trenton on the 2d of April
and October.

Pennsylvania, at Philadelphia on the 11th of
April and 11th of October.

Delaware, at Newcastle on the 27th of April, and
at Dover the 17th of October.

Maryland, at Annapolis on the first of May, and
on the 7th of November at Easton.

Virginia, at Richmond on the 22d of May and
November.

For North Carolina, at Wake Court House, or at
Raleigh the 1st of June, and 30th of November.

South Carolina, on the 6th of May and 25th Oc-
tober at Charleston.

Georgia, on the 20th of April and the 8th of No-
vember at Savannah and Augusta.

When any of the above fixed days happen to be
on Sunday, the court is opened on the Monday fol-
lowing.
