To each of these districts are assigned a commanding officer of the army of the United States, and a competent staff.

The following rules are prescribed with regard

to militia drafts.

United States, must be made under the requisition of some officer of the United States (regularly authorised to make such requisition) on the executive authority of the state, or of the territory from which the detachments shall be drawn.

2d. In these requisitions shall be expressed the number of privates, non commissioned and commissioned officers required; which shall be in the same proportions to each other, as obtain in the re-
