Rates of Piotage.—From Baltimore to sea, three dollars for each foot of water the vessel shall daw.

From sea to Baltimore, three dollars and fifty cents for each foot of water the vessel shall draw.

From sea to the district of Columbia, in Mary-land or from thence to sea add one fifth of the above rates. And on vessels not owned by citizens of the United States, add one third of the above rates.
