

Silver less pure than the standard, to be defaced by the assayer and returned, the worker to pay like fees to the assayer as if the metal had been standard silver.

Manufactured silver, of a decedant's estate not subject to the operation of the assay law.

The general issue to be pleaded, and special matter given in evidence, and if judgment be given in favor of defendants or plaintiffs non-suited, defendant to have treble costs.

Fines under 50 dollars recovered before a justice of the peace ; above 50 dollars in the county court, one half for the use of the city, the other for that of the informer.

The assay mark is the shield in the state arms, shape oblong square, with corners taken off, and the Dominical letter of the year.
