Baltimore street, incorporated in 1810: Capital 365,000 dolls. Discount days Tuesdays. Notes offered for discount must be put in on Monday before one o'clock. Philip Moore, president, James Dawes, cashier.

Farmers' and Merchants' Bank,

No. 252, Baltimore street—Capital 500,000 dollars, divided into shares of 50 dollars each—Discount day, put in Wednesday for Thursday; day of election, first Monday in April. William Grahame, president; John Duer, cashier.

City Bank,

North-east corner of Gay and Second streets—Capital 1,500,000 dollars—Discount day, Monday. Day of election, first Monday in June. John Donnell, president; James Sterett, cashier.

Marine Bank of Baltimore,

North-west corner of Alisanna and Market sts. F. P.—Capital 600,000 dollars; divided into shares
