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BALTIMORE COLLEGE.

This Seminary is founded by a Charter from the state ; under the direction of a respectable board of trustees, with the privilege of conferring degrees.

The present Faculty consists of the rev. Samuel Knox, A. M. Principal ; the rev. William Sinclair, V. Principal, and Mr. Francis Little, professor of Mathematicks and Natural Philosophy ; and two tutors.

The number of students, in the different branches of literature and science, is generally about one hundred and twenty ; but some funds or annual endowment by the state, would be necessary to place the institution on the best foundation for the more advanced parts of liberal education.

VACCINE INSTITUTION.
