Friday September 9th
 66 AM Mod^{te} Bz² & cloudy. Daylight ~~at~~ boat rett Ausd sigl as per
 Sea margin. Weighed & made sail in C^o with the Squad^u & Prizes,
 47 Ausd sigl Genl. ~~at~~ 10 Ausd sigl as per margin. Squadron were
 43 joined off Point Lookout by HM Ship Tourant (Vice Adm^l Cochrane)
 Albion (R^o Adm^l Cockburn) & Warspite, ~~Dictator~~ ^{Dictator} Surprise,
 Wolverine, Madagascar. Noon Fresh Bz² & clear. PM D^oW². Lay to
 one of the Prizes in Tow. Ausd several sigls from the Albion as per
 margin 10 came to with the Best Bower in 11 fms water 12 D^oW²

Saturday Sept 10th
 SW AM Lt Bz² & clear. At daylight weighed & made sail with the
 Squad^u - Running up the Chesapeake. At Noon Lt. Bz² & fine.
 PM D^oW² made & shot^d sail occ^{ly} to keep in our station. At 4 D^oW²
 shortened sail & came to in 8 fms with the small bower, furl'd
 sails. At Midnight Fresh Bz² & cloudy. Veered to a whole cable.

Sunday Sept 11th
 AM Fresh Bz² & clear. Daylight weighed & made sail - Running up
 the Bay of Chesapeake in C^o with the Squad^u. Noon Rear Adm^l
 Cockburn came on board & hoisted his flag. Lt. Bz² & clear
 PM D^oW² at 2 saw the Town of Baltimore. Came to in 5 fms
 water, furl'd sails. Midnight Fresh Breezes.

Monday Sept 12th
 AM D^oW², at 2 came alongside boats of the Squadron with
 Troops. 4 D^oW². Daylight boats emp^d landing Troops. 10 weighed
 & made sail. Noon D^oW² came to in 4 1/2 fms water
 PM D^oW². 3 weighed & made sail standing higher in shore
 5 came to in 4 fms water with the Best Bower 8 D^oW² Midnight D^oW²

Thursday September 13th
 AM Strong Bz² & cloudy with rain. Daylight weighed & made sail
 standing in for the Harbour, at 10 came to off Point. Bomb
Vessels commenced bombarding the Enemy's Forts who opened
a heavy fire upon the Squadron from three batteries. Ausd
telegraph from Seahorse. Noon D^oW² PM D^oW² carried away the
 hawsers in warping. 4 D^oW² Ausd telegraph from Seahorse
 at 6 Sent the Marines under arms on board HMS Hebees
on a particular service. 8 D^oW²
