

Date Wind Remarks etc HMS TERROR in Chesapeake Bay.

Tuesday Sept. 6 1814

AM Mod^{te} By^s & cloudy (4) D^oW^s (6) Fresh By^s & cloudy. At 6³⁰ came on board two Masters from the Ranillies. Weighed & made sail toward Tangier Island. (8) Lt. By^s & clear. At 9 Tack^d ship, trimmed sails as necess^y. At 11³⁰ sent Ranillies cutter with the Master ahead to sound. Noon Lt. airs & v^{ble} Standing in for Tangier Island. East PM Fresh By^s & cloudy W^s. Trimmed sails as necess^y standing in toward Tangier Island. At 12⁴⁰ short^d sail & came too with the v^{ble} small bower in 9 fms water. Furl^d sails. At 3 the Master of Ranillies & Surocying Master left the ship. At 4 Fresh By^s (6) Mod^{te} By^s & cloudy W^s (8) D^oW^s (10) Fresh By^s & squally W^s 12 D^oW^s

Wednesday Sept. 7, 1814

AM Fresh By^s & squally W^s. At 4 More Mod^{te} (6) Fresh By^s & cloudy W^s. SW Eup^d sparring the rigging down for rattling. At 8 D^oW^s People eup^d about the rigging etc. At Noon Lt. By^s & cloudy W^s. Eup^d setting up & rattling down the rigging - Single anchor of Tangier Island. PM Mod^{te} & fine W^s. At 1 weighed & made sail, sounded NE from 5 to 13 fms standing out from Tangier Island. At 4 D^oW^s Admiral W^bN 3 miles. (8) Mod^{te} & cloudy W^s. Made & short^d sail as necess^y. At 7³⁰ brought too with the small bower in 9 1/2 fms. Furl^d sails & ~~reared~~ ^{reared} to 1/2 a cable - 10 Fresh By^s & squally with heavy Thunder, lightning & rain.

Thursday Sept. 8, 1814

AM Fresh By^s & squally with thunder lightning & heavy rain. (4) D^oW^s at 6³⁰ weigh^d with the Fleet & made sail. At 8 mod^{te} & brayy. Admiral & Fleet in Co. At 11³⁰ tack^d & sig^l & made sail up the Patowmack. at Noon Lt By^s & fine W^s. Admiral SW NW Squadron in Co working up the Patowmack. PM Lt airs & clear W^s. At 12¹⁵ Tack^d ship. At 4 Lt. By^s & cloudy. Squad^{rs} & convoy in Co (6) D^oW^s Adm^l & Squad^{rs} in Co, (8) Lt. By^s & v^{ble} at 9³⁰ heard several guns. Ans^d sig^l to anchor. WNW Short^d sail & came too with the small bower in 9 fms. Adm^l NW^bN Midnight squally with thunder & lightning. Sq^s of Transport in Co.
