Friday September 9, 1814	Vble NNW NNE NNE/SE NNE Vble NNE	AM Fresh By ^s & squally W ^s with Thunder & lightning (4) D ^o W ^s at 5 ¹⁰ Aus ^d sig ^l to weigh. Weigh ^d & made sail in C ^o with the Admiral & Squadron. At 8 ³⁰ set the foresail & aus ^d sig ^l to tack. Tack ^d sleep. At 9 ³⁰ aus ^d sig ^l to close by the Royal Oak. Tack ^d slip & made sail to close. Trimmed sails as necess ^y . At 11 set the staysails. Noon D ^o W ^s running down the Potomac. PM Mod ^{te} of fine W ^s . Tack ^d occ ^{ly} working to windward in C ^o with the Fleet. At 1 ³⁰ aus ^d sig ^l 180 fired a gun shotted & brought to a boat. Sent her to the Adm ^l . Aus ^d sig ^l 213 Captain went on board the Admiral. At 2 ¹⁰ Capt. return ^d . Hoisted up boat, fill ^d & made ^d sail. Tack ^d occ ^{ly} working to wind ^d at 4 D ^o W ^s Adm ^l & Squad ⁿ in C ^o . - Tack ^d occ ^{ly} . At 7 ¹⁰ shortened sail & came to with the small bower in 7 fms, furl ^d sails. Royal Oak SSE. At 8 fresh By ^s with lightning. Squad ⁿ & Convoy in C ^o . 12 D ^o W ^s .

At 4¹⁵ weigh^d & made all possible</u> <u>sail up the Chesapeake.</u> At 8 Lt. By ^s Adm ^l N ^o E, Squad ⁿ in C ^o . (10) Lt. winds of fine W ^s . Trimmed sails as necess ^y & made all sail <u>with studding sails up the Chesapeake.</u> Noon D ^o W ^s Adm ^l & Squad ⁿ in C ^o . running up the Chesapeake. PM Mod ^{te} By ^s & clear W ^s . Trimmed sails as requisite. at 4 D ^o W ^s Adm ^l , Squad ⁿ & Convoy in C ^o . at 6 D ^o W ^s Adm ^l N ^o W Convoy in C ^o at 8 D ^o W ^s made & short ^d sail as necess ^y . Adm ^l & Squad ⁿ in C ^o . <u>At 10 short^d sail & came too with the small bower</u> <u>in 7 fms.</u> at 12 Fresh By ^s & cloudy W ^s Squad ⁿ & Convoy in C ^o .
Sunday Sept. 11, 1814	SSW Vble E ^{ly}	AM Mod ^{te} By ^s & cloudy W ^s at 5 ³⁰ short ^d in cable. At 5 ⁴⁵ aus ^d sig ^l to weigh Weigh ^d & made all sail in C ^o with the Adm ^l & Fleet. Made all sail - at 8 Mod ^{te} of fine. Made & short ^d sail occ ^{ly} . Adm ^l & Fleet in C ^o . at 8 ³⁰ short ^d sail & came too with the small bower. At 11 ³⁰ weigh ^d & made ^d sail. Noon D ^o W ^s aus ^d sig ^l to close with Adm ^l Coetzbeem. Standing in for Balto. PM Mod ^{te} of fine. The Capt. went on board HMS <u>Severn</u> . At 1 ³⁰ aus ^d sig ^l 213. At 1 ⁴⁵ weigh ^d & made sail with HMS <u>Surprise</u> bearing <u>the Admirals Flag and 2 Brigs of War</u> running up to Baltimore. <u>At 2³⁰ anchored in 3¹/₄ fms with the stream anchor, Surprise</u> <u>& Brigs at anchor in C^o. Baltimore NW 2¹/₂ miles. 8 D^oW^s.</u>
