

Friday September 30, 1814

Wind West
Remarks etc. HMS Terror in the Chesapeake Bay.
 AM Mod^{to} & fine at 3³⁰ D^W: weigh^d & made sail. Set studding
 sails. At 4 D^W: Running down the Chesapeake. At 9 Lt. airs
 & fine - Strange sail in sight. At 11 made our N^o to HMS
 Dragon. Noon D^W: PM Lt. winds & fine W^z. At 1 shifted
 studding sails. Captain went on board the Dragon. At 3
 NE anch^d sig^l to close, in studding sails & came to the wind
 on the Larb^d tack. At 4 Lt. By^z inclining to calm. Tack^d ship.
 East at 5 D^W: at 5²⁰ sprung up a brisk breeze from the SE
 at 5³⁰ closed the Dragon, up Fore sail & hove too.
 at 6 D^W: the Captain ret^d, up boat, Tack^d & made sail.
 at 6³⁰ in royals & staysails. At 7³⁰ in Royals (sic) and in
 2^d reefs. At 8 mod^{to} & fine, up Main sail, in T^g sails, down
 jib, 2 ships to windward & saw a frigate & a brig at
 anchor. At Midnight D^W.

Saturday October 1, 1814

Wind ENE
Remarks etc.
 AM At 1³⁰ came too with stream anchor in 6 1/2 fms. at 5³⁰ weigh^d &
 made sail in C^o with HMS Seahorse. At 7³⁰ obs^d D^o to anchor.
 E^{1/2}N Short^d sail, at 8 Fresh By^z & rain. - Mod^{to} with rain, short^d sail
 E^{1/2}N & came too with the stream anchor in 7 fms. at 10 saw 2 ships
 at anchor east 4 miles. Noon D^W: PM Strong By^z & squally with
 rain. At 5 squally with heavy rain. Found the ship to drive.
 ENE at 5³⁰ let go the small bower anchor, furl^d sails, sent down
 Royal & Top^g yards, and pointed the yards to the wind. Veered
 out the whole of stream & to half a cable of the small
 bower. At 6 D^W: Ranged the Best Bower. At 8 D^W: at 10 Set Fore
 Topmast staysail at 11 Down D^o (10) Fresh By^z & cloudy. 12 D^W

Sunday Oct. 2, 1814

Wind NNE
Remarks etc.
 AM Fresh By^z & cloudy, 4 D^W: 5⁵⁰ unmoored, & weigh^d the stream made
 N^oW sail to join HMS Madagascar & Majestic at anchor East 4 mi. 7¹⁰
 WNW short^d sail & came too with the B. B^z in 10 fms. Out reefs, veered to 1/2
 a cable. 8 More Mod^{to}. 9 Anch^d HMS Seahorse. 9²⁰ rec^d 24 Sep⁴ Boys
 from the Madagascar. 10³⁰ anch^d HMS Devastation with schooners.
 NW Noon D^W: Single anchor Cape Henry 3 1/2 E Quittis Isl. NE 1/2 E.
 Calm PM Lt. airs inclining to calm. Eref^d & Pudding up the ring of the
 small B^z anchor. At 2³⁰ sailed HMS Seahorse & Cochecher. Bent
 the small B^z cable. At 4 calm & clear, short^d sail. At 4³⁰ furl^d
 S sails. 8 D^W: a light breeze from the southward (10) Mod^{to} & fine
 12 D^W.
