

Work Day M<sup>o</sup> W<sup>h</sup>o Remarks etc. HM Advice Boat Anna Maria July 1814

29<sup>th</sup> SE AM | Calm and clear w. Towed into Baylies Bay to copper. Rec'd 46 shot boxes from HM Ship Tonnant. At noon D<sup>o</sup>W<sup>e</sup> PM D<sup>o</sup>W<sup>e</sup> Emp <sup>unboarding</sup> 500 shot from HM Ships Royal Royal Oak and 10 Puncheons from HM Ships Tonnant.

30<sup>th</sup> Calm AM | Calm & clear weather. Towed out of Baylies Bay. Saut main Topmast on deck, found it sprung, unrigged the jing mast - Carpenters variously employed - Unrigging the Main Mast. Noon Calm & fine. 1 p.m. D<sup>o</sup>W<sup>e</sup>. Rec'd 15 men from HM Ship Rover. Midnight D<sup>o</sup>W<sup>e</sup>.

31<sup>st</sup> SW AM | Moderate and fine weather. Scrubbed Hammocks and logs. Deserted Robt<sup>t</sup> Edwain & W<sup>m</sup> Calpera. Noon D<sup>o</sup>W<sup>e</sup>. Rec'd a weeks provisions from HM Ship Tonnant. D<sup>o</sup>W<sup>e</sup>

AUGUST 1<sup>st</sup> West AM | Moderate & fine w. Sailed HMS Tonnant, gammoned the bowsprit & set the botstays up. Rec'd 15 tons of ballast from HMS Bacchante and Furieuse. Employed stowing D<sup>o</sup>. PM | D<sup>o</sup>W<sup>e</sup>. Came alongside the Bermuda with our Masts. Sent D<sup>o</sup> to Royal Oak. Employed as above. Midnight D<sup>o</sup>W<sup>e</sup>.

2<sup>nd</sup> WSW AM | Light breezes and fine. At 10<sup>30</sup> Boats came alongside to tow us to Royal Oak. Rec'd 5 tons of ballast from Bacchante. PM | D<sup>o</sup>W<sup>e</sup>. Got the Mainmast out & new fore & main D<sup>o</sup> in. Hauled off from Royal Oak. Employed rigging & getting ready for sea. At Midnight D<sup>o</sup>W<sup>e</sup>.

3<sup>rd</sup> SW AM | Moderate and fine. Rec'd 130 fathoms of rope from Furieuse. Employed bending sails, setting up rigging and otherwise as requisite, getting ready for sea. At 10<sup>30</sup> weighed and made sail through the North Rocks Passage. Royal Oak & Convoy in C<sup>o</sup>. PM | D<sup>o</sup>W<sup>e</sup>. Employed bending foresail. Made & shortened sail as requisite for Convoy. At 5 North Rock West, St Davids Head SEBS 12 or 13 miles. At 8 D<sup>o</sup>W<sup>e</sup> Royal Oak and Convoy in C<sup>o</sup>. At 12 D<sup>o</sup>W<sup>e</sup> Royal Oak and Convoy in C<sup>o</sup>.
