At 3 weighed and made sail with Squaceron. At 4 ³⁰ came to with the (BB) in 7 fms off Fore Point Fleet in Company At Midnight D ^o W ^r Fleet in C ^o .
Friday	16 th		AM Mod ^{te} of fine W ^r . Emp ^d setting up lower rigging & stays. Noon D ^o W ^r PM D ^o W ^r Supplied HM Ship Sea Horse with grape and canister of 12 and 18 P ^r order - At Midnight D ^o W ^r supplied Sea Horse with round shot per order of Commander in Chief.
Saturday	17 th	West	AM Mod ^{te} & cloudy. At 10 ³⁰ ans ^d sig ^l to weigh. Weighed & made sail Fleet in Company beating down the Chesapeake. Noon Strong Winds & squally PM D ^o W ^r at 1 in 1 st & 2 nd drops of Main sail. At 2 got the Bonnet off the jib. At 5 ans ^d sig ^l to anchor. Bore up to join Fleet and came to with the BB in 8 fms. At 6 veered to 1/2 a cable. At 8 strong winds and squally with rain. At Midnight D ^o W ^r .
Sunday	18 th	West WNW	AM Strong breezes & cloudy W ^r with strong squalls. At daylight ans ^d sig ^l to weigh. At 6 weighed and made sail down the river. At 8 ³⁰ ans ^d sig ^l to pass within hail. At 8 ⁴⁰ made sail for the sternmost of the fleet. At 9 saw a schooner on shore. Came to and sent a boat on (per order) to get her off. At Noon Ditto Weather. PM D ^o W ^r at 1 boat returned not being able to get schooner off. Aligned & made sail after fleet. At 4 D ^o W ^r Fleet out of sight. At 5 ³⁰ shortened sail & came to with the (BB) in 5 fms off the Patuxent River. Admiral and fleet in company. At Midnight D ^o W ^r
Monday	19 th	South	AM Mod ^{te} of fine W ^r . At daylight ans ^d sig ^l 216. At 6 weighed and made sail further up the Patuxent. At noon D ^o W ^r weather. PM D ^o W ^r at 4 ³⁰ went alongside Sea Horse to get gun out of the remainder of her shot. At 5 sailed the Commander in Chief with Part of the Fleet. At 7 hauled off from Sea Horse. At Midnight Strong Breezes and Squally.
