Tuesday	20 th	SSE	AM Moderate & fine. At daylight went alongside of the Albion & got refugees out. At 8 weighed & made sail under the orders of Admiral Cockburn. At 10 went close in shore to look out. Noon D ^W beating down the river. PM D ^W anchored as requisite in shore getting stuck. At 10 ³⁰ came to with the BB at Midnight D ^W
Wednesday	21 st	SSE	AM Mod ^{te} & fine W ^z . At daylight weighed and made sail beating down the Bay of Tangier. At noon D ^W in 2 reefs of the Main Sail and took the Bonnet off the jib. Short ^d sail as requisite to keep up with admirals. PM D ^W at 7 anchored off Smiths Isl ^d . At Midnight ^{strong breeze & squally} D ^W
Thursday	22 nd	SSE	AM Mod ^{te} & fine. At daylight weighed & made sail. At 8 saw several strange sail ahead. Made & shortened sail as requisite to keep up with the Squad ⁿ . At Noon D ^W PM D ^W beating up for Tangier. At 7 ³⁰ Short ^d sail & came to with the BB in 3 fms off Tangier. At Midnight D ^W
Friday	23 rd	SSE	AM Mod ^{te} & fine. At daylight sent the remaining refugees on board the Albion and rec ^d one days provisions for 13 men. Weighed & made sail for Watts Island. At 9 came to at D ^o . At noon D ^W sent boats on shore. PM D ^W at 1 weighed & made sail for Tangier. At 3 ³⁰ came to with the BB in 5 fms veered to 1/3 of a cable. At 5 ³⁰ sighted anchor. At Midnight D ^W weather.
Saturday	24 th	SSW	AM Mod ^{te} & cloudy W ^z . At 8 ³⁰ went alongside Albion. At 10 got two 18 pdrs from her and 5 weeks provisions. At noon D ^W PM D ^W at 1 hauled off from Albion & went to Watts Isl ^d . At 3 came to in two fms. Set up the lower rigging & staysails. At 7 shifted further out. At Midnight D ^W .
