


Remarks etc HM Advice Boat Anna Maria in Chesapeake Bay

Sunday	25 th	SW	AM Mod ^{te} & fine W ^z . At daylight weighed & made sail for Tangier. At 6 ³⁰ bore up for Watts Isd. At 11 made sail for Albion. D ^o and Hebrus beating out of Tangier. At noon D ^o W ^z .
		SWNW	PM D ^o W ^z emph ^d getting ready for sea, filling Salt Water and as otherwise requisite. At 4 ³⁰ short ^d all sail for squall from NW. At 5 close reefed Main Sail & jib. Set them and bore up with Admiral. At 7 ³⁰ obs ^d Admiral anchor. Shortened sail & came to with the (BB) in 7 pms found her driving. Veered to the Clinch & brought her up. At 8 D ^o W ^z . At Midnight Strong
		WNW	breezes with a heavy sea from NW Albion & Hebrus in Company.
Monday	26 th	NW	AM Strong Breezes with a heavy sea from the NW & heavy thunder & lightning. At daylight ansd sig ^l to weigh. Weighed & set square sail and main sail. At 9 ³⁰ short ^d sail & hove to in
		NNW	Lynhaven Bay, found her HMS Majestic. At 10 ansd sig ^l to go on board Admiral. At 11 made all sail on the starboard tack
		Vble	having dispatches for Rear Admiral Malcomb. At 6 ⁴⁰ short ^d sail & hove to for boat from Majestic. At 7 made sail lape
Tuesday	27 th	WSW	Heavy Light House SE BS 6 or 7 miles. At 10 ¹⁰ short ^d sail & came to with the BB in 6 pms. At Midnight Lt. winds & fine.
		NNW	AM Lt. B ^y 's & cloudy. At daylight weighed & made sail working to windward between the Spit & Middle ground. Came on board
		SW	9 slaves. Lt. B ^y 's inclinable to calm. At 11 ¹⁰ came to in 6 pms with the BB, New Point Comfort NW 12 or 14 miles. Exercised small arms firing at a mark. At noon calm & clear W ^z . PM calm & hazy. At 4 sprung up a light breeze from NNE, weighed & made sail. At 6 New Point Comfort NW 6 or 7 miles. At 8 sprung up a breeze from NW. Set square sail and top sail. At Midnight D ^o W ^z up the Bay.
Wednesday	28 th	SW	AM Mod ^{te} & fine. At 12 short ^d sail & came to in 5 pms off Tangier Shoal. At daylight weighed & made sail Windmill Pt ^s SSW Smiths Pt ^s NNW. At 6 saw several sail ahead. At 8 ³⁰ spoke HMS Bruce, saw the Admiral at anchor off Georges Isd ^l hauled up for D ^o . Lt. B ^y 's beating up the Patowmack. At 12 anchored & sent the
		NNW	boat with the dispatches. PM D ^o W ^z . At 1 ³⁰ sprung up a Lt. B ^y . from the south ^z . Weighed and made sail, at 5 anchored off Georges Island. At Midnight Moderate & fine weather.
