

In the month of May a Party did arrive but consisting
only of one Captain, three Subalterns, five sergeants, and
four corporals, the latter officers servants; a few days since
Lieut. Col. Brown of the 6th West India Regt arrived here
and to morrow proceeds with the Party to the Bluefields
to try what can be done with the Blacks that have already
emigrated. but I have great apprehensions in which I
am joined by the Lt. Col. that the strength of this Party is
by no means adequate to the service and I beg leave to
suggest to your Excellency that a Subaltern's Party at
least from each Regiment be sent here, and that they be
furnished with a proportion of clothing to ^{dress} those
first recruited, which may have the good effect of
inducing others to enlist.
