

I am informed that very few if any of the provisions
shipped in the Mats have been issued and I
therefore recommend Mr Collier taking the whole
charge and obtaining the proper Receipts for what
have been delivered that their distributions may
regularly appear. Before your arrival
I pointed out to Mr Collier what Stores I thought
necessary to remove from one Transport to the other
in order to make a general Apportionment in both
they will deliver their Cargo seperately, which I
could wish still to have executed, and have only
that what you may have to send the Mats, be
received for conveyance on board the Erebus
