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ready to sail from Providence had proceeded
to Havanna to take the benefit of any Spanish
Convoy calling there, and as his Majesty's
Sultan has in all probability touched at Havana
to take up the homeward bound ships before this
period, I have directed that a ship of war should
call at New Providence about the 21st March
take on such homeward bound Trade as may
be ready to proceed to Bermuda to join the
Convoy that will sail from thence on the
1st April, of which I request your Excellency
be pleased to apprise the Shipping Interest. I
this opportunity of acknowledging also your
Excellency's Letter of the 15th Dec. The Convoy
was to have taken up a Cannibary that was
to have been at Providence collecting Prizes there.

I shall attend to your Excellency's wishes whenever
opportunities offer of sending Specie to Halifax.
