Sir
I send a Victualer to New Providence with Provisions for the use of the Squadron under your command, which you will be pleased to land with utmost possible dispatch. You will find on board a proportionate quantity of all species, except the articles of Bread, Flour and Beans, of which there is to be a double proportion, and half the quantity only of Beef and Pork. I request to be informed what farther supplies you can provide for the Squadron.

You are to hoist the Cartel Flag on the Ship Speedwell and receiving on board such American Prizes as may be sent you proceed with them to the entrance of the Rigolets and there deliver them with the Letters addressed to Commissioner Patterson and when an answer can be sent from the Rigolets by the Ship that go up tomorrow to any Officer authorized by the American Government of New Orleans to give receipts for them; having done which return to the Ship without loss of time.
