As the Season is now advancing,  
I recommend your moving round to the other  
Coast and calling here for reinforcements, after leaving  
a proper force to protect the Indians. Where you  
can deposit your spare provisions as I take it for  
granted that the supplies from Jamaica will  
have arrived, before this date. Those from Bermuda  
and Providence must be at no great distance,  
I think you ought to be here at the time of the Equinox  
so as to avoid the usual Gale. Should the

Victuallers arrive the only supplies you will want  
here will be Bullocks, Fruit and Vegetables, and  
I hope you will be able to be upon the Coast of Georgia  
should the war continue in the first week of April

If the Peace is confirmed you will have to act  
agreeably to the Orders of Government relative to the  
destination of the Troops but I am clearly of Opinion  
that it can be attended with no further good you  
remaining longer where you are. Captain

Spencer may be left with the Cydnus - and such they  
say two or three as have not Acting Captains
