to enter into Arrangements for an Armistice
which should extend throughout the Territories
of both Parties including the Coast along
the Atlantic; — As I could not

think of entering into any Stipulation whatever
for the Naval Commander of His Majesty's
Fleet on the American Coast, and that
Colonel Pinkney could not agreeably to
his instructions recede from his requisition
on this head, and as on our part it was
required as a pledge of the sincerity of
the desire of the American Government for
Peace, that the rupture of the Negotiation
pending at Gottenburg should be the
sole ground for the dissolution of the
Armistice by either party, to which requi-
sition Colonel Pinkney did not conceive
himself warranted to accede, and had

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
