Sir

Having received several
communications from Their Lordships,
announcing an intention of sending out
frigates and Brist is Frigate, Stores &c
but being perfectly silent with respect
to a reinforcement of Seamen, which
of all things is the most important -
from the strong representations made
to Government by Sir John Warren,
Sir George Prevost, and myself. I did not
entertain a doubt on the subject,
particularly as Sir John desires me to
send back the crews of the Sloops, im-
mediately on my Reinforcements arrive
in the Spring -
