| 3 June 1814 | Barron | Transmitting a long report from Capt. Nourse of Seamen of a cruise in violation of orders extending as far from Bermuda as Cape Verde Islands with many details, and of Admiral Boscawen's orders; and to consider a court martial. |
| 10 June 1814 | Barron | sending circular of instructions for distribution (missing) |
| 10 June 1814 | Barron | "Newcastle" and "Clinker" gun-brig being sent to him. |
| 11 June 1814 | Barron | Recd Admiral Milne to remain aboard "Melrose" until released |
| 14 June 1814 | Barron | List of officer promotions/commissions with associated fees to be paid: Admiral £5,716, Captain £2,130, Lt. £1,116 (about 1 month's salary)?? |
| 14 June 1814 | Barron | "Raynard" sloop accompanying "Newcastle" for his orders. |
| 14 June 1814 | Barron | Recd ^{Home} Mr. Smith 1 st Sgt RM (Melrose) to attend court-martial |
| 15 June 1814 | Barron | American Flag-of-truce "Chauncey" has forfeited right by clearing an English brig and sending someone on board. |
| 16 June 1814 | Barron | ^{sloop} "Calliope" is joining "Newcastle" "Clinker" and "Raynard". |
| 17 June 1814 | Barron | No more further moorings needed at Spanish Pt. Bonn. |
| 20 June 1814 | Barron | "Escort" and "Sharpshooter" gun brigs joining Newcastle et al |
| 21 June 1814 | Barron | sending 5 commissions for officers (Rt) |
| 23 June 1814 | Barron | withdrawing request that Smith be sent to England. see ltr 29 May |
| 27 June 1814 | Barron | approves justification for 3 mos. leave to Lt John Parnon |
| 27 June 1814 | Barron | approves his modification of location for Hospital |
| 27 June 1814 | Barron | states ltr of 2 May perished, merino sentenced to death ^{20 April} ^{conduct} |
| 27 June 1814 | Barron | requiring Capt. Nourse to reply to complaint of cruel & tyrannical |
| 27 June 1814 | Barron | states ltr of same date answer his ltr of 20-24 April. |
| 28 June 1814 | Barron | send S. R. Whitecomb Mid back to England. |
| 29 June 1814 | Barron | agrees to discharge purser of "Melrose" |
| 29 June 1814 | Barron | Detailed listing of new establishments of inferior officers and workmen at Bermuda Dockyard. |
| 29 June 1814 | Barron | Refuses to enlist British N.A. Seamen on condition they be ^{allowed to} remain on station. agrees to send an offer to men who operate small craft for local service, consistent with Navy regts. |
| 29 June 1814 | Barron | sanctions transfer of paymaster from 2 nd to 1 st batt ⁿ RM. |
| 1 July 1814 | Barron | transfer of 2 ltr to other ships. |
| 5 July 1814 | Barron | transmits cc of French Treaty of Peace dtd 30 May (included)
