 April 1 - Sept 24, 1814

<u>Date</u>	<u>From-To</u>	<u>Abstract</u>
6 July 1814	Barron	all excess boys at Plymouth being sent out on board "Akbar"
5 July 1814	Barron	disallowing promotion of John Jane as Lt. for "Arab"
6 July 1814	Barron	Sending "Escort" and other sloops to proceed from Halifax with gun-boats being sent, all to be under his orders.
8 July 1814	Barron	Commission for 8 officers - Capt Wainwright from ASCA ^{to Tonnant}
9 July 1814	Barron	Lt. Thomas Barron to be employed on N.A. Station
11 July 1814	Barron	Lt Crook? being sent back for court martial - AU OC.
12 July 1814	Barron	Acknowledges letter up to 31 May (receipt of)
12 July 1814	Barron	Masters of merchant ships who sail w/o convoy will be prosecuted
12 July 1814	Barron	Authorizing payment of \$2000 to American who had conducted the expedition against Sloop shipping in Comm. River (see MS 2326 for transcribed copy of this action) on 9 April
12 July 1814	Croker	No negotiations for an armistice are to be entered by him. Encloses Balthurst's orders to Prevost and Geo that if one has been signed it is to be <u>terminated</u> .
12 July 1814	Croker	"Cassio" being sent to his command.
19 July 1814	Barron	Send James Spottswood, Bay back to England.
14 July 1814	Barron	Approves his refusal, addressed to merchants of Halifax, to relax strict blockade of American coast.
14 July 1814	Croker	directs him to order "Scamander" (ex "Lively") to return immediately to England.
15 July 1814	Barron	transmits printed report of Nat'l Vaccine Establishment dated 25 May. Enjoying great success since Jenner's discovery ^{12 yrs.} ago.
26 July 1814	Barron	transmits cc's of Spanish pledge of strict neutrality and Goulburn's letter stating blockade could not be relaxed in favor of merchants of Halifax
20 July 1814	Barron	cannot reinstate former Dispenser of Halifax hospital.
20 July 1814	Barron	refuses to confirm appointment of Jrs. Ludliff as Lt.
22 July 1814	Barron	refuses to confirm interim appt of unconfirmed Purser.
22 July 1814	Barron	Letter of congratulations for Capt Coots re his successful and gallant attack in Connecticut River.
26 July 1814	Croker	requests witnesses he sent to England for court martial of Capt Barclay re loss of Battle of Lake Erie.
28 July 1814	Barron	promotion of three men to lieutenant.
