30 July 1814	<u>Barron</u>	transmitting letter from a merchant in London complaining that cotton is being smuggled through Amelia Island to Liverpool at prices which undercut legitimate purchases and asks that the blockade be enforced there.
29 July 1814	<u>Barron</u>	authorizes 14 supernumeraries @ for 3 of his vessels.
1 Aug 1814	<u>Croker</u>	orders him to take Lt. w/ dispatches under his orders.
1 Aug 1814	<u>Croker</u>	orders another dispatch vessel to return to England.
1 Aug 1814	<u>Croker</u>	directs that he report the disposition of the military forces, or the use of naval forces, which may be undertaken by Genl Ross. Also in certain cases you may enter into any of the West India stations, or send in one or more flag officers to execute a particular service. (See MS 2326, 29 Dec 1815)
3 Aug 1814	<u>Barron</u>	discharge John Griffiths, apprentice.
5 Aug 1814	<u>Croker</u>	copies of H. R. H. proclamation recalling, and prohibiting natural born Britons from serving in U.S. Forces.
5 Aug 1814	<u>Croker</u>	Dispense with logs lost in a wreck, and captain's certificate for passing a candidate to Lt. to be
8 Aug 1814	<u>Croker</u>	orders discharge of a master's mate & mid and sent to England
8 Aug 1814	<u>Croker</u>	do for a mid and volunteer on board "Junon"
8 Aug 1814	<u>Croker</u>	transmits revised private signals - others compromised. ?
9 Aug 1814	<u>Croker</u>	sending "Penguin" to Halifax for his fleet.
9 Aug 1814	<u>Croker</u>	asking senior officer Bermuda to forward a secret packet being sent to V. A. Cochrane.
9 Aug 1814	<u>Croker</u>	He says ^{says} that a ship in so bad repair as "Orpheus" should not have been sent to Halifax but directly to England - report of inspectors attached.
10 Aug 1814	<u>Croker</u>	Sending an American pilot, James Parker, in the "Amphion" to serve as a pilot or otherwise.
10 Aug 1814	<u>Croker</u>	"Pictou" and "Dominica" commissioned with Lt. C.O.'s.
