Abstract

- 29 Aug ¹⁸¹⁴ Croker - direction to employ Lt. John Scott in any vacancy.
- 30 Aug 1814 Croker - sending (3rd Rate 74) to Quebec, to place whole of his ship's co. (except himself and his warrant officers) as well as 100 supernumeraries and all his guns, ammunitions and stores, masts, yards etc at disposal of Commodore Yeo for service on lakes, and lay up his ship for the winter; and he is not to divert any of the material for his own use.
- 30 Aug 1814 Croker - denying permission to carry excess miles of mates awaiting promotion. ~~At~~ ^{As} BIA's special supernumeraries for wages and victuals, but place them on board ships with vacancies.
- illegible date Croker - sending 400 seamen and 100 boys to fill vacancies in the fleet.
- 3 Sept 1814 Croker - sending 100 private marines with double NCO's to complete vacancies in squadron.
- 6 Sept 1814 Croker - requests info on an apprentice whose discharge is sought.
- 13 Sept 1814 Croker - the printer being sent is only to be paid after embarkation.
- 13 Sept 1814 Croker - statement of the Fleet books issued to ships of ^{Transcribed} War and Transports proceeding to America. (only about 10 sent ^{up to 1803} ^{to during 1814} ^{beginning of War})
- 15 Sept 1814 Croker - No prisoners to be landed at New Providence ^{or Jamaica} unless ^{permitted} by ^{order} of ^{the} ^{governor}.
- 17 Sept 1814 Croker - Commissions for 3 officers
- 22 Sept 1814 Croker - Acknowledges receipt of letters then 29 July
- 22 Sept 1814 Croker - appoint 2 senior boatswains to be with to please her
- 22 Sept 1814 Croker - directing that he assign "Leander" and "Newcastle" to side-by-side service and conduct a comparative evaluation of their performance as they have been constructed on diff. principles.
- 23 Sept 1814 Croker - ordering him to appoint an admiralty midshipman ^{acting as} to fill vacancy of ^{on board} H.B. Slepton promoted to Lt. on board Leopold.
- 24 Sept 1814 Croker - denying his appointment of a parser to Florida (ex 05 ship Frolic) and designating a new one from England.
