Sir,

I have the Honour to ~~inform~~<sup>acquaint</sup> you that the necessary Shipping has been appropriated and is now on the point of Sailing from this Country to Bermuda in order to convey the 102<sup>nd</sup> Reg<sup>t</sup> from thence to Halifax. This Corps has been placed under your orders for the purpose of enabling you to occupy and maintain possession of the Islands in the Bay of Passamaquoddy; and I am to signify to you the Pleasure of His Royal Highness the Prince Regent that you should make the necessary arrangements in concert with the officer commanding His Majesty's Naval Forces for carrying into effect His Royal Highness's intentions upon this Subject as soon as you shall have received the reinforcement before mentioned.
