Abstract

To R. Adam Hatham ^{secret} supplement to order for retaliation to be given to Captains and Commanders to ~~prevent~~ the islands in LI Sound, Morragansett Bay, Marthas Vineyard & Nantucket and tell people at New London their property will be reflected if they do not interfere with attacks on US Ships. Also determine strength of Fort Griswold; height of parapets etc. & size of garrison.

To Capt Hardy; surveying master De Mayne ^{sworn?} in most secret manner to sound near Annapolis, Thomas R. and all places suitable for landing an Army thereabout & also above Potapoco for attacking Baltimore. Make a number of copies showing appropriate anchorages for ships of different sizes & draft. If you can acquire sufficient small vessels this or next month try to capture vessels & tobacco at the known swamp canal & the entrance to Cockeyhack Sound also Albermarle Sound. In reflecting retaliation per my Secret Memo of 19 July put the burden of suffering on adherents of the President's party - give people who have contributions levied on them a certificate to prevent being levied twice. Elizabeth City is destination of goods sent from Norfolk by channel.

6 Sept 1814

To Capt Gordon of 5th REGT. Orders on how to distribute 1000 add'l stand of arms to Indians through Nicolls, and use of \$6000 to purchase provisions for Indians if need be.

19 Sept 1814

To Lt. Mercer Deliver enclosed message to R. Adam Brown.

19 Sept 1814

To R. Adam Brown in Jamaica putting him under A.G.'s orders.

Chesapeake

The army on US Coast is to be sent to join the Army of Lt. Gen. Lord Hill off Pt. Negre and proceed to attack N. Orleans. You will collect Pilots and boats suited to penetrate Lake Pontchartrain & complete victuals on their arrival. As soon as you hear of R. Adam Malcolm's approach, leaving the US on 10 Oct. I plan to arrive on Nov. 2 stopping along the way at Leeward I where if may meet Lord Hill. In the mean time you will take any small draft vessels you may have or may procure and adapt them for this purpose mounting one or more guns upon them.
