24 Apr. 1814	25	Cochran	reporting recapture of Schooner "Hark" by "Recruit" on 22 Mar. Also that Constitution had been chased into Cape Ann by 2 frigates and had struck ground and was hauled ashore - and US vessels Frolic Enterprise and Rattlesnake were at sea and US embargo to be lifted on the 10 th Apr.

25 Apr. 1814	29	Cochran	U.S. ^{having} received naval supplies through neutral trade to New York and Labrador & Northward and ^{now following to do so} drawing revenue from the cargoes, will remove the embargo to continue building the new Line of Battle ships and sloops and privateers now close to completion and are preparing to fit out for sea, he plans to extend the blockade to all ports east of Long Island. 26 Apr. 1814	30	Cochran	"bulwark" has arrived and "Sceptre" to depart today with convoy of 22 Merchant ships and return to England for repairs.
27 Apr. 1814	31	Cochran	The "Sceptre" convoy took a large no. of prisoners, for which masters of merchant vessels refused responsibility to deliver. Since it was underway he ordered Capt. Deousshire to remove them to his own ship prior to reaching England & transmits a list.
27 Apr. 1814	32	Cochran	crews of ships in Bermuda have not had fresh provisions since his arrival on Mar. 7 and cattle cannot be obtained from US by means of Bills of exchange. Therefore has raised cash by advertising publicly and will furnish it to senior officers for buying meat & vegetables - also doing this for blockade ships.
27 Apr. 1814	33	Cochran	sends copy of passport given to charge d'affaires of Denmark and his family to return home from the US.
28 Apr. 1814	34	Cochran	sends copy of Letter to Mr. Barclay to require a decision on whether the US will agree to exchange prisoners
28 Apr. 1814	35	Cochran	sending dupe of #29 via "Caeso" - pls return "Caeso" ASAP
