- 21 Oct. 1813 Croker - Warren - Convoy service shall remain unchanged.
- 18 Nov. 1813 Croker - Warren - sending letter from St. Domingo merchants re losses sustained due to lack of protection (below)
- 16 Oct. 1813 to Croker - whole of ships have been captured etc etc.
- 26 Nov. 1813 Barrow - Warren - Stationary allowance is £100 / annum.
- 30 Nov. 1813 Barrow - Warren - Ordered to register Loup-Corvier (ex Wasp) under name Peacock 14-32 for carronades, 2-6 pdrs, 121 men.
- 30 Nov. 1813 Barrow - Warren - Ordered to appoint a petty officer to fill vacancy on Sceptre in which Charles Flood is acting.
- 2 Dec. 1813 Barrow - Warren - Acknowledges receipt of Punishment Report for 3rd Q 1812^(sic) (report included)
- 3 Dec. 1813 Barrow - Warren - Acknowledges Punishment Report for 1st and 2nd Q's 1813 (report enclosed) for dates in 1812-13 - seems to be period complained of in 1813 letter
- 7 Dec. 1813 Barrow - Warren - Asking for inquiry into fate of crew of Plumper, lost on Nov. 6, 1812 & whether Lt. was saved.
- 14 Dec. 1813 Barrow - Warren - Asking facts re court martial involving Capt. Brenton & Stackpole which was ordered by not convened.
- 24 Dec 1813 Croker - Warren - Approving his action in transferring ^{to named} ships to orders of R. Adam Griffith on 20th Nov. to blockade Boston
- 27 Dec. 1813 Adm^{ty} - Cochrane - Commissioning him C in C and ordering him to take Asia at Spithead and wait there for further orders. plus letter of transmittal from Barrow. plus order to administer oath of allegiance to officers he appoints and send certification thereof. plus grant of authority to convene courts martial plus " " " to issue Commissions & Warrants
- 28 Dec 1813 Barrow - Warren - Revoking paroles granted by Capt. Coot of Bore to 21 American Prisoners of War at Falmouth
- 28 Dec. 1813 Barrow - Warren - Asking why Pickers might not have brought specie from Bermuda instead of sending it by convoy.
- 28 Dec. 1813 Barrow - Warren - Acknowledging receipt of various reports etc.
- 28 Dec. 1813 Barrow - Warren - asking for results of court martial re loss of Plumper (see 7 Dec. above)
- 28 Dec. 1813 Barrow - Warren - Approves commissioning of ANACONDA and appointment of Westfield to her command.
