25 Jan Order to take MS 2342 (cont)
Asia + Super to Bermuda (Dec 1813 - Mar 1814)
and assume command.

Date From-To Abstract

25 Jan 1814 Barras - Authorizing employment of Lt. John Dundas Cochrane in any vacancy in fleet in N.A.

25 Jan 1814 Barras - Complete statement of the ammunition and stores being furnished to Asia, Bulwark, Superb, & Saturn for each of the 5 1/2 inch howitzers and 9 pdr. Field Pieces on board.

26 Jan 1814 Barras - Pay off officers of Success and use elsewhere if poss.

26 Jan 1814 Croker - Extract of Capt. Barrie's ltr of 14 November re the flood of negroes defecting to his ships.

26 Jan 1814 Croker - Transmitting previous correspondence with Adm. Warren, Paron de Nicolay, and orders from Castlereagh re the offer of the Emperor of Russia to ~~negotiate~~ mediate an end to the war, and reiterating the government's unwavering direction that Cochrane is not authorized in any way to enter into negotiations concerning the points of difference between US and Gt Brit. contains 2 open and 2 secret enclosures.

26 Jan 1814 Croker - Transmits notification of end of hostilities with Denmark

26 Jan 1814 Barras - Stating the sum of £7170.3.2 for bills drawn by H. Briarly will be suspended until substantiating documents are sent, and in meantime he will continue to receive his pay.

31 Jan 1814 From Admiralty - announcing appointment of Mr Lockwood and (Anthony) De Mayne to survey coast of America under his orders and direction. Encloses copy of Lockwood's orders and established rate of pay at one guinea ^{21/5} / day!

26 Jan 1814 Barras - transmits commissions for Lts. Geo. Bury & H.D.C. Douglas

27 Jan 1814 Croker - 2nd partⁿ of R.M. (except artillery Co.) will be assigned to ships on St. Fakes; surplus staff and capt. will be sent to him to use as he sees best fit.

1 Feb 1814 Barras - sending copies of orders re protection of compasses, sale of effects of R.N. men, and issuing lime juice and sugar.

1 Feb. 1814 Barras - encloses opinion of solicitor as to eligibility of acting captains to sit on courts martial.

4 Feb 1814 Admiralty Circular re responsibility and increase in pay of carpenters to ensure they purchase and use necessary tools to continually repair leaks etc. on board ship
