Albion on the Potomac
15 August 1814

Vice Admiral

The Honorable Sir A. Cochrane

Sir

According to the permission you were pleased to give me last night, I landed again within St. Mary's Creek this morning with the Marines under Col^d Malcolm, and accompanied by Captains Sir Peter Parker and Palmer and the other Captains of the Squadron, meeting however in the different parts of the Country which we visited today the same quiet and submissive conduct on the part of the inhabitants as in the places we visited on the 12th instant - we returned again to the Ships in the Evening without any material occurrence, and as the whole of this Country bordering the Potomac has now been visited I propose in compliance with your Directions to join you tomorrow with the Ships under my Command
