Aged 21<sup>2</sup> Entered on board His Majesty's Ship Dragon, on the 5<sup>th</sup> May 1811 says he is a Native of America born at Norfolk, and that he was pressed by the Opofsum Brig, out of the Ellis South American Trader, he produces two Certificates, by which he appears to be a Subject of America. he stands charged on the Books of the Dragon, for Slops Beds and Tobacco <sup>S. & D.</sup> No. 150.

Non the Ships Books 656. James Belfour A.B. Entered on board His Majesty's Ship Dragon, on the 26<sup>th</sup> June 1811. says he is a Native of Virginia, that he was pressed by the Granada Brig, out of the Young Posidon, belonging to a Mr. Hays a Prize Agent at St. Johns, he has not produced any Certificates of Birth, or any Protection, as he says all his papers having got Wet, were totally destroyed he was sent from the Granada on board the Dragon and stands charged for Slops, Beds and Tobacco. <sup>S. & D.</sup> No. 110.

Non Ships Books 650. George Gray G.M. Aged 25 Entered on board His Majesty's Ship Dragon, on the 13<sup>th</sup> July 1811, says he is a Native of Rhode Island, and that he was pressed by the St. Christopher, out of the Lydia of London he produces no proof of being an American, but says that the Captain of the St. Christopher, took both his protection and Certificates, promising to give them them again, and to procure him his discharge from the Service on his arrival at Antigua, but the Captain of the St. Christopher leaving the Ship, took both his Certificates and Protection with him, he was drafted from the Brachne into this Ship and stands charged for Slops Beds and Tobacco <sup>S. & D.</sup> No. 15.

Non Ships Books 355. James Guedron Bro. Aged 25 Entered on board His Majesty's Ship Dragon on the 5<sup>th</sup> September 1812 says he is a Native of America born at New York and was pressed out of the Phoenix of London by the Kingdove stating himself to have served on board that Vessel from 5<sup>th</sup> day of September 1812 to the 12<sup>th</sup> day of
