This it appears he tendered to the Clerk of the Cheque at Antigua and wanted to receive the Bounty but the Clerk of the Cheque could not pay it him as the Officers refused to sign their Names to his Bounty. Iist supposing he might have received the Bounty before he was drafted from the Kingdove into the Dragon and stands charged for Stops, Beds & Tobacco 7^l 6^s 3^d.

Non Ships Books R3. Daniel Brown Carpenters Mate, Aged 29 Entered on board His Majestys Ship Dragon on the 6th September 1810 says he is a Native of New York Pressed about two years and a half ago by the Pompee out of the John Schooner belonging to Salem he produces an American Protection and a Certificate he appears on his Ships Books from the Pompee to have received Five Pounds Bounty and stands charged on the Books for Stops, Beds and Tobacco 14^l 10^s 2^d.

Non Ships Books S61. Samuel Ward Quarter Gunner, Aged Entered on board His Majestys Ship Dragon on the 20th May 1812 says he is a Native of America born at New Jersey. Pressed by the Minerva out of the good Man of Alderney and that he lost both his Certificates and Protection while on board the Minerva, he was drafted from Cherub into the Dragon and stands charged on the Books for Stops, Beds and Tobacco 8^l 15^s 11^d.

Non Ships Books T56 William Willicock A.B. Aged 44 Entered on board His Majestys Ship Dragon on the 6th Sept^r 1810 says he is a Native of Connecticut America and was pressed in the Downs from the English Homeward bound East Indiaman, Aquillon by the Victor, and that he formerly belonged to the American East Indiaman Hazard, and
