dispatch, Sir, and to receive your decisions,  
and, if it be that, on delivery of the five  
Prisoners now known to be held at Norfolk,  
and of any others, who may have, since my  
last information, been secured / of which he  
is directed to report to you, he may proceed  
on his Voyage, his Orders are to go immediately  
to Norfolk, receive the prisoners from the  
Marshal who has corresponding directions,  
and to deliver them on board such of your  
Ships, as you may direct. As to those  
who may remain, after such delivery,  
if it take place, and the Analoostan departs,  
I beg leave to repeat to you, the assurances  
given to Col<sup>l</sup> Barclay, that no exertion shall  
be spared, to recover, and deliver speedily, or to  
account for on the fairest principals, every  
Man who can be found.

I have the honor to send you,  
under this envelope, a few Copies of the  
Cartel, lately agreed upon, between Col<sup>l</sup>  
Barclay and myself, the provisions of which,  
I trust will be found equally advantageous, to both  
Nations.
