

the whole and every part thereof the Court is of opinion the Charge is proved.

The Court does therefore adjudge Patrick Hallidan to Suffer Death, by being hanged by the Neck until he is Dead, at the Yard Arm of such of His Majesty's Ships or Vessels and at such time as the Commander in Chief shall think proper to direct, and the said Patrick Hallidan is hereby adjudged so to be hanged until he is dead accordingly.
