David Boyd 4 th prepare anchorage at wells & dip more 5 th Prepare anchorage for prison ship 6 th prepare residences for Yard officers and CMC 7 th Remove civilians from Ireland Is. to prevent liquor from being furnished to workmen & seamen. 8 th Consult Evans re feasibility of further improvements. 9 th Central deployment of Marine Guard 10 th Dispatch Great Tanks at Tobacco Bay & make weekly return of water taken by the Ships 11 th Keep floating tanks & admiral's tender in repair 12 th perform strict inspection of Naval Hospital.
