

Week, according to the state of the weather by an Officer, and the reports to be collected and sent weekly to Head Quarters.

Instructions relative to Iceland.

A Patrol to go round the Island morning and evening in boats to be suffered to land but at the Dock Yard, nor at the East End without a pass, and all vessels coming to the Island to be visited to prevent Liquor being smuggled into it.

No person to be permitted to land at the Dock Yard without an Order from Commodore Evans, or the Senior Officer of the Yard, or who have business or employment in the works upon the Island.

No person to be allowed to visit or inspect the works or Buildings without an Order from Commodore Evans and a pass granted for that purpose.

Strict order is to be kept upon the Island, any person or Inhabitant offending or acting contrary to these Orders is to be removed off the Island, as well as persons detected in Smuggling or selling Liquor.

If any of the Boats are employed fishing or returning to the Island, they must come to the Crows to where the Centinels are stationed, & report at 11 o'clock, 12 o'clock, 1 o'clock, 2 o'clock, 3 o'clock, 4 o'clock, 5 o'clock, 6 o'clock, 7 o'clock, 8 o'clock, 9 o'clock, 10 o'clock, 11 o'clock, 12 o'clock.
