

foregoing Regulation immediately on the
Receipt of the Order, and the other half as
soon as the Passengers embark.

In cases where circumstances may
have arisen to prevent the Passengers from
embarking, the half allowance, first
authorized to be drawn for is to be retained
by the Captain, but if it should happen
that the Passengers shall have embarked, and
after the Captain has drawn the whole
allowance, be relanded, or transhipped to
some other Vessel, in this case the
Captain will be called on to refund the
half of the passage money authorized
to be drawn for on embarkation, retaining the
other half as before stated.

These Rules will be most rigidly
adhered to and if any officer shall act
inconsistently with them, he must himself
be liable for every expense incurred.
