 Cloudy M^o Dragon not in Sight.

 At 12.15. Bore up. Fresh
 Breezes with Rain -
 At 2.30. Anchored in Lynhaven
 Bay with the Best Bower in
 6 1/4 fms. Veered to a whole
 Cable. Light House on the
 Cape Willoughby Point
 N 1/2 N. furled Sails.
 found at anchor 19 ships
 Maidstone, Junon,
 Belvidera, and Lauretinas
 anchored here also the Poitiers
 and Victorious, Fantome, made
 sail to cruise off Cape Henry.
