- 1 AM
- 2 Fresh Breezes with Rain
- 3 At 4 $2\frac{1}{2}$ PM
- 4 5.30 Weighed & proceeded
- 5 Proceeding up the Chesapeake Squadron
- 6 in Co. made and shortened
- 7 up sail occasionally at 6.45
- 8 PM Saw New Pt. Comfort & House
- 9 the town.
- 10 At 9. Squally with heavy
- 11 Rains. At noon Moderate
- 12 Breezes and Cloudy PM Squadron in Co.

Smith's Pt. Light House W. by S.

- 1 Proceeding PM
- 2 up Moderate Breezes and
- 3 the Cloudy PM At 12.10 hauled up
- 4 for Patowmack River At 12.15
- 5 saw HMS. Sandomingo and
- 6 several others. At 4 $2\frac{1}{2}$ PM
- 7 At Single At 5.30 Shortened sail and
- 8 Anchor PM Anchored with the West
- 9 between Clements Bower in 7 fms. veered to $2\frac{1}{2}$
- 10 and St. George's Cable. - furled sails. found at
- 11 Islands in the Anchor here. HMS. Sandomingo
- 12 Marlborough, Diadem, Deomed,
- Woolwich, and Mariner Rock
- Ships.
