

Transport (No. 520) to proceed onto
St. George's Harbor to deliver over
with the utmost expedition the
whole of the things provisions now
on Board of her to the Rolla
Transport, & you are to direct the
Alexander to remain in the Harbor
with the only agent the Ballast
Board of her, in constant readiness to
receive and proceed to sea with an
entire cargo of Bread whenever a Vessel
(daily expected) shall arrive thence.

As it is of high importance to
the forwarding of His Majesty's Service
in these Seas, that the Provisions
now in the Alexander should be
changed to the Rolla as above directed
as quickly as possible & the latter Vessel
got ready for sea, I request that all
the Boats and all the Strength of
the Transport at this place may be
forthwith employed hereon, and I
trust to your zeal for causing the
same to be effected with the least
possible delay.
