the 28th October 1874

Sir,

In answer to your Letter
dated the 22nd Instant but which I
have only this day received, respecting
Bread Bags furnished to His Majesty's
Ship *Hebrus* when under immediate
Orders for sailing - I have to inform
you that if you will notify the
description of Certificate and demand
in such cases required by your contract
I will direct their being forwarded to
you from the *Hebrus*, but I do not
see any occasion to give any
particular Order for that Ship being
supplied with the said Bags
differently to other Ships, as she was
here quite long enough after receiving
the said Bread to have returned the
Bags or to have given any Certificate
respecting them had she been required
so to do.
