St. John at Bermuda the 8
November 1814

In the absence of the Commander in Chief
I have the Honor to acquaint you for the
information of my Lord Commissioners of the
Privy Council, that the *Pique* and *Porcia* have
lately arrived here with the Dispatches with
which they were respectively charged; which
Dispatches I have forwarded to the Commanding
Chief.

The *Amphion* has also arrived here
this day with *Convey*, and under Order from
their Lordships to take *Convey* home from
hence, but the *Diadem* and *Dolphin* being
in pursuance of Directions from the Commander
in Chief on the point of proceeding with *Convey*
to England as the *Amphion* came in, and
the *Diadem* being filled with sick and
wounded soldiers and sailors in a bad state,
and that *Amphion* having been reported not to
