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be in a condition to continue ahead, I have
not judged it right to alter the arrangement
respecting her in consequence of the Commodore's
arrival.

The latter ship will therefore when
she has completed her water and is ready to
return, take charge of such vessels as are not
now prepared to accompany the Diadem,
or should there be none such, she will
return singly, obeying in her way equally
to Her Lordship's instructions respecting her.
