I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt
of your letter transmitting to me the proceedings
of a Court of Inquiry which you directed to
examine into the Complaints preferred in ^{last} the
last ~~last~~ letter of the ^{the} instant against
Lieutenant Moran of the 1st Garrison Battalion
and informing me that a deserter from the 1st
Garrison Battalion had been captured in a
boat belonging to His Majesty's Ship *Arcturion*
& lodged in the Main Guard. This Man I shall
of course immediately direct to be discharged
from His Majesty's Naval Service so soon as he
is identified as a deserter from the Army, and you
will therefore be pleased to give such further
directions as to his disposal as you may think
proper.
